

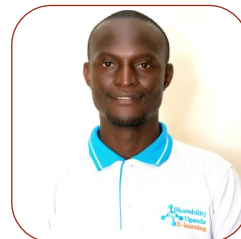

Weight: Numerical value assigned for purposes of grading for each performance level.
